FARM ANIMAL FACTS

Language: big, small, fat, legs, ears, wings, beak, tail, grass, carnivore, herbivore,

fish, cereals, milk, swim, fly, run; it's, it's got, it can

Resources: Farm animal facts activity sheets, (card, glue, scissors)

a) Print off the sheets and stick onto card. Cut up the cards to give you a pack of 24 cards for each group of 3-4 players.

- b) Shuffle the cards and place them in a pile face down on the table.
- c) The first player takes a card. S/he reads the sentence aloud to the other members of the group. In turn, they have to give an example of an animal that fits the description. They get a point for each correct answer. The card goes to the bottom of the pack.
- d) The next player takes the next card and the game continues. The winner is the player with the most points.
