## Teacher's notes

## DOMINOES

Language: Jack, Mum, Daisy, the stranger, the giant, the giantess, the beans, the beanstalk, the castle, the hen, the eggs, the coins, the harp, the axe, Jack's cottage

Resources: Dominoes activity sheets, scissors, glue, card
a) Stick the dominoes sheets onto card.
b) Cut out the dominoes.
c) Divide your class into groups of 3 and give each group a set of dominoes.
d) Demonstrate the game. Shuffle and deal the dominoes. Each player picks up, and looks at, his/her cards. They do not show them to the others!
e) Player 1 puts one of his/her cards on the table, face up.
f) Player 2 puts down a card that matches one of the sides of the card. If s/he does not have a matching card, s/he misses a go.
g) Player 3 puts down a matching card or misses a go.
h) The players continue, in turn, in the same way. The player who puts down all his/her cards first is the winner.
