

Language: "What's your favourite animal?"; farm animals
Materials: questionnaire grid; flashcards (optional)

1. Ask the children to name all the farm animals they have learned. Write them on the board or blu-tac the flashcards.
2. Ask one or two of the children, "What's your favourite animal?". Ask all the class to repeat it.
3. Have one child ask another, "What's your favourite animal?" Do this until all the children can ask the question.
4. Give out copies of the questionnaire grid. Explain how to complete it.
5. Have the children ask the neighbour on their right "What is your favourite animal?" As the class hears the answer they should mark it on their grid.

6. When everyone has finished, show them how they can display the information. You may want to ask their Maths teacher to help them.
